In 2016, UMBC library tech of 7 years Vivien Barrett died by suicide.



In the note that she left, she expressed that suffering from her supervisor Paula Langley's abuse contributed to her mindset. Langley only started working at the library the year prior but wasted no time in making her discriminatory hatred for Mrs. Barrett and other employees apparent.

At least 9 other employees have quit their jobs at the library due to Langley's harassment, and she's been the subject of multiple Office of Equity and Inclusion investigations, with no discernible result. Langley specifically targets trans women such as Mrs. Barrett, using slurs, bodily insults and constant misgendering, even in front of other employees.

UMBC has consistently shielded her from the repercussions of her abusive management.
